A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Health Amendment Act, 1903." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Health Amendment Act, 1904." Short Title.

2. For the purposes of sections four to seven of "The Public Health Amendment Act, 1903," the expressions "Hospital Board" and "Board" shall include and be deemed as from the passing of that Act to have included a "District Board" under "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885." "Hospital Board" defined.
