A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Health Amendment Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Public Health Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Section one hundred and eleven of the Public Health Act, 1908, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

Section 111 of principal Act amended.

“(e.) Prohibiting the use of houses or any class of rooms therein for human habitation that in the opinion of the District Health Officer are unfit for such habitation.”
