A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make Better Provision for the Observance of certain Title.

Days as Public Holidays.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays Act, 1910.

2. Where in any Act or in any award or industrial agreement reference is made—

Short Title.
Certain holidays to be observed on a Monday.

(a.) To Labour Day, such reference shall hereafter be deemed to be to the fourth Monday in October, and not to the second Wednesday in October;

(b.) To Dominion Day, such reference shall hereafter be deemed

to be to the fourth Monday in September;

(c.) To the Sovereign's birthday (also to be celebrated as Empire Day), such reference shall hereafter be deemed to be to the next succeeding Monday when such birthday falls on a Sunday.

Struck out.

(d.) To Empire Day, such reference shall hereafter be deemed to be to the day fixed for the celebration of the Sovereign's birthday.

(e.) To Christmas Day or New Year's Day, such reference shall, when those days fall on a Sunday, hereafter be deemed to be to the next succeeding Monday, and in that case any reference to Boxing Day shall be deemed to be to the next succeeding Tuesday.

3. (1.) Section fourteen of the Labour Department and Labour Repeal.

Day Act, 1908, is hereby repealed.

New.

(2.) Section one of the same Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "and Labour Day."

Schedule of bank holidays.

Amendment of Factories Act. 4. The Third Schedule to the Banking Act, 1908, is hereby repealed and the Schedule hereto substituted in lieu thereof.

5. Section thirty-five of the Factories Act, 1908, is hereby amended by omitting the proviso to paragraph (a), and substituting the following:—

"Provided that when Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on a Sunday, then the holiday shall be allowed on the next succeeding Monday."
