A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Lands in the Patea Harbour Board. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Patea Harbour Board Foreshore Act, 1903." Short Title.
- 2. All the foreshore of the sea below high-water mark lying between the mouths of the Waingongoro River and the Waitotara River shall, by force of this Act, be and become vested in the Patea Foreshore vested in Patea Harbour Board.
- 10 Harbour Board as an endowment.
- 3. All those parts of the beds of the Waingongoro River and the Waitotara River respectively over which the tide flows and reflows, and all those parts of every river, creek, bay, and arm of the sea between the Waingongoro River and the Waitotara River over which Further lands vested in Patea Harbour Board.
- 15 the tide flows and reflows, shall, by force of this Act, be and become vested in the Patea Harbour Board as an endowment.
- 4. The Patea Harbour Board may from time to time let any part or parts of the lands hereby vested in it, for any term or terms Harbour Board may lease lands.
- 20 not exceeding twenty-one years in possession, at such rents and subject to such conditions as the Board shall from time to time determine.
