A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Lands in the Patea Harbour Board. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Patea Harbour Board Foreshore Act, 1903." Short Title.

2. All the foreshore of the sea below high-water mark lying between the mouth of the Kaikura River and the point marking the boundary-line between Sections 362 and 363, Block X., Wairoa Survey District, shall, by force of this Act, be and become vested in the Patea Harbour Board as an endowment. Foreshore vested in Patea Harbour Board.

3. All that part of the bed of the Kaikura River respectively over which the tide flows and reflows, and all those parts of every river, creek, bay, and arm of the sea between the Kaikura River and the point marking the boundary-line between Sections 362 and 363, Block X., Wairoa Survey District, over which the tide flows and reflows, shall, by force of this Act, be and become vested in the Patea Harbour Board as an endowment. Further lands vested in Patea Harbour Board.

4. The Patea Harbour Board may from time to time let any part or parts of the lands hereby vested in it, for any term or terms not exceeding twenty-one years in possession, at such rents and subject to such conditions as the Board shall from time to time determine. Harbour Board may lease lands.
