A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Property Law Consolidation Act, 1883." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Property Law Consolidation Act 1883 Amendment Act, 1898." Short Title.

2. Section fifty of "The Property Law Consolidation Act, 1883," shall henceforth be read and construed as if the following words occurring therein, in brackets, "(six clear months' notice of an intention to pay the same having been given)" had been originally omitted therefrom, and had never appeared therein. Necessity for six months' notice by mortgagor abolished.
