'AN ACT to amend "The Property Law Consolidation Act, Title. 1883."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Property Law Consoli- Short Title. dation Act 1883 Amendment Act, 1900."

- 2. For the purpose of entitling any mortgagor in the case of an One month's 10 overdue mortgage to pay off on one month's notice, in lieu of six notice substituted for six. as prescribed by section fifty of "The Property Law Consolidation Act, 1883," that section is hereby amended by substituting the word "one" in lieu of the word "six." Every such notice shall be in writing under the hand of the mortgagor, his solicitor or agent.
