A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Exemption of the Papanui Memorial Hall from Liability for Rates. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Papanui Memorial Hall Management Amendment Act, 1932, and shall be read together with and be deemed part of the Papanui Memorial Hall Management Act, 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. The Papanui Memorial Hall and Library mentioned in the principal Act and the land whereon the same are situate, being all that parcel of land containing by ad-measurement thirty-two perches, being the whole of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 324, folio 37, Canterbury Registry, are hereby exempted from liability for payment of all general, special, and other rates which at the date of the passing of this Act have been levied or demanded, or which may hereafter become leviable, by the Christchurch City Council or any other local authority having rating-powers affecting the said land and premises. Exemption from payment of rates.
