A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Port Molyneux Reserves Leasing Act, 1876."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Port Molyneux Reserves Leasing Short Title. Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1880."

2. It shall be lawful for the South Molyneux Road Board to lease for any Board may lease period not exceeding twenty-one years any portion of the said reserves at such rent and on such conditions as to the said Board may seem fit: Provided that the area leased shall not at any time exceed one-half of the total area of the said reserves, and that the leased portion of the said reserves shall always be open

half of reserves.

3. The said South Molyneux Road Board may issue yearly licenses to the Board may grant inhabitants of the Port Molyneux Subdivision of the South Molyneux Road over unleased Board District to depasture cattle on the unleased area of the said reserves.

depasturing licenses

The said Board, or any of its servants, is hereby empowered to impound any 15 cattle trespassing on the said reserves as if the same were lands belonging to a private owner.

4. The powers of issuing licenses granted to the aforesaid South Molyneux Consent of Road Board by the third section of the Ordinance of the Provincial Council of leases not necessary. Otago intituled "The Port Molyneux Reserves Management Ordinance, 1875,"

20 may be exercised by such Board without the sanction and consent of the Superintendent as provided by said section.

5. The second section of "The Port Molyneux Reserves Leasing Act, 1876," Repeal. is hereby repealed.

New Clause.

25 6. All moneys received from leasing the land shall be devoted to the improvement thereof.
