PALMERSTON NORTH HOSPITAL DISTRICT.

MEMORANDUM.

The object of this Bill is to divide the Wanganui Hospital District. It has the unanimous support of the Local Bodies of the district, and the Hospital Board of the present district has passed a resolution recommending the constitution of the new district.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Palmerston North Hospital District Act, 1891." Short Title.

10 It shall be read and construed together with "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885" (herein referred to as "the said Act").

2. The said Act is hereby amended as follows:—

The First Schedule of the said Act is hereby amended as follows:—

Amendment of "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885."

15 In the description of the Wanganui District, after the word "Rangitikei," omit the words "Oroua and Manawatu," and insert the word "and" between "Waitotara" and "Rangitikei."

After the aforesaid description, insert

"DISTRICT OF PALMERSTON NORTH.

20 "All that area in the colony being the Counties of Oroua and Manawatu, and including all the boroughs therein."

25 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in clause thirty-four of the said Act, the District of Palmerston North shall hereby be separated from the United District of Patea and Wanganui for the purposes of charitable aid.
