This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

3. Power to lease any portion of the land. 4. Repeal.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to vest certain Lands in the Board of Governors of the Title. Palmerston North High School.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Palmerston North High Short Title. School Reserve Act, 1905."

2. The parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby lands vested in the Board of Governors of the Palmerston North High Palmerston North School for an estate in fee-simple for the purposes of the Palmerston High School. North High School.

3. (1.) The Board of Governors may from time to time lease Power to lease any portion of the said land not immediately required for the pur-15 poses of the High School.

(2.) The provisions of "The Public Bodies' Powers Act, 1887," shall apply to every such lease.

(3.) The rents and profits of every such lease shall be applied by the Board towards the maintenance of the High School, and the 20 improvement of the grounds thereof.

4. Section three and the Second Schedule of "The Palmerston Repeal. North Reserves Act Amendment Act, 1901," is hereby repealed.
