A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873."
Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Protection of Animals Act 1873 Amendment Act, 1879." Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act, it shall not be lawful for any Resident Magistrate or Justice of the Peace to commit to prison any person offending against the provisions of section six of "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873," in default of the payment of the penalty therein prescribed. Abolition of imprisonment for offence against section 6 of "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873."
