## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Protection of Animals Act Amendment Act, 1875," and it shall be read and construed with "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873."

2. No person shall hunt take or kill any seal except during the months of June, July, August, and September in each year, under a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds for each seal so hunted taken or killed.

3. This Act shall not extend to the Auckland Islands.
