A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Promissory Oaths Act, 1873."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Promissory Oaths Act Amendment Act, 1893." Short Title.

2. No officer or person mentioned in "The Promissory Oaths Act, 1873," or in the Schedules thereto, who has once duly taken the oaths required by or under that Act upon his acceptance of an office, shall be compelled or required to take such oaths again in respect of any subsequent appointment or election to the same office; and this provision shall be deemed to have been in force and to have formed part of "The Promissory Oaths Act, 1873," at the date of the passing thereof: Declaration no person compelled or required to take oaths again upon reappointment or election to same office.

Provided that nothing herein shall affect the operation of the seventeenth section of the said Act. Proviso as to operation of section 17 of principal Act.
