A BILL INTITLED

AN ACT to amend "The Police Offences Act Amendment Act, 1890." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Police Offences Act Amendment Act, 1894." Short Title.

2. In lieu of the words "whose function it shall be to keep a constant look-out" in section two of "The Police Offences Act Amendment Act, 1890," there shall henceforth be read the words "part of whose duty it shall be to keep a careful look-out." Traction-engines.
