A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Police Offences Act, 1884."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Police Offences Amendment Act, 1900," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Police Offences Act, 1884" (hereinafter called "the principal Act").

Short Title.

2. Subsection twenty-nine of section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting the word "or" next after the words "public place."

Further offence as to breach of peace.

3. Section twenty-six of the principal Act is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection:—

Extension as to idle and disorderly persons.

"(4.) Who habitually consorts with reputed thieves or prostitutes or persons who have no visible means of support."
