### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Police Offences Amend-  
ment Act, 1908, and shall form part of and be read together with  
the Police Offences Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal  
Act).

Short Title.

10 2. Section forty of the principal Act is hereby amended by  
inserting after the words "one year" the words "or to a fine  
not exceeding *twenty* pounds."
