A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Police Offences Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Police Offences Amendment Act, 1920, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Offences Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Subsection one of section seven of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph thereto:—

Section 7 of principal Act (relative to cruelty to animals) amended.

“(f.) Promotes, takes part in, or in any manner encourages, aids, or assists in any competition in marksmanship in which any such animal is released from any enclosure, or from any trap or other receptacle for the purpose of being used as a target.”
