#### POLICE OFFENCES AMENDMENT BILL

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title and commencement of the Bill, which is to come into force on 1 January 1968.

Clause 2 amends the Police Offences Act 1927 and several amendments to that Act so as to alter many of the penalties prescribed for offences. In most cases the maximum fine is increased but in some cases the term of imprisonment at present provided for is omitted or reduced.

In one respect the summary jurisdiction of a Magistrate's Court is increased. At present a person may be prosecuted under paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Act if he wilfully destroys or damages any property for the destruction of or for damage to which no other punishment is prescribed by the Act if the property destroyed or, as the case may be, the damage to the property, does not exceed in value the sum of \$40. This Bill removes the reference to the sum of \$40 so that a prosecution may be brought under the paragraph irrespective of the value of the property or damage.

#### A BILL INTITULED

### An Act to amend the Police Offences Act 1927

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Police Offences Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Offences Act 1927\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the first day of

(2) This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

- 2. Review of penalties—(1) The principal Act (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the First Schedule to this Act.
  - (2) The enactments specified in the Second Schedule to this Act (as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) are hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.
