### A BILL INTITULED

#### An Act to amend the Post Office Act 1959

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
5 as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Post Office  
Amendment Act 1971, and shall be read together with and  
deemed part of the Post Office Act 1959 (hereinafter referred  
to as the principal Act).

10 2. **Regulations relating to the Telephone Service**—The  
principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after section  
112 the following section—

“112A. Any regulations made under paragraph (c) of sub-  
section (2) of section 112 of this Act shall not come into force  
15 unless and until—

“(a) They have been gazetted;

“(b) They have been laid before Parliament and referred  
to the Statutes Revision Committee of the House  
of Representatives; and

20 “(c) They have been approved by a resolution of the House  
of Representatives.”

**3. Regulations**—The principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after section 168, the following section:

“168A. Any regulations made under paragraph (h) of subsection (2) of section 168 of this Act shall not come into force unless and until—

“(a) They have been gazetted;

“(b) They have been laid before Parliament and referred to the Statutes Revision Committee of the House of Representatives; and

“(c) They have been approved by a resolution of the House of Representatives.”
