A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of Jurors.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Payment of Jurors Act, 1895." Short Title.

2. The Ninth Schedule of "The Juries Act, 1880," is hereby repealed. Repeal of the Ninth Schedule of "The Juries Act, 1880."

10 3. (1.) All jurors, whether grand, special, or common jurors, shall be paid the sum of seven shillings and sixpence to each juror for every day he may be in attendance upon a Court. Payment of jurors.

15 (2.) Every juror travelling to attend a Court shall be entitled to a further sum sufficient to cover the railway or other fare when the distance travelled is *five* miles or upwards.
