Title	157. Transitional provisions
1. Short Title and commencement	157A. First Schedule amended

**An Act to amend the Protection of Personal and
Property Rights Act 1988**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be
5 cited as the Protection of Personal and Property Rights
Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and
deemed part of the Protection of Personal and Property Rights
Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the
10 1st day of October 1988.

157. Transitional provisions—Section 117 of the
principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection
(4), the following subsection:

“(4A) Every person who is deemed by subsection (3) or
15 subsection (4) of this section to be a manager appointed under
this Act shall, subject to any order of the Court made on an

157A. First Schedule amended—The proviso to paragraph (r) of clause 1 of the First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “for a term of not more than”, and substituting the words “for a term of more than”.
