A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Duration of the Present Title.
Parliament.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Prolongation of Short Title.
Parliament Act, 1941.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in
10 section two of the Electoral Amendment Act, 1937, the
House of Representatives as existing at the passing of
this Act shall, unless the General Assembly is sooner
dissolved, continue until the first day of November,
nineteen hundred and forty-two, and no longer.
