### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to prevent the Purchase of Votes for Returning Members to the House of Representatives. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5     **1.** The Short Title of this Act is "The Prevention of Purchase of Votes Act, 1882." Short Title.

10     **2.** (1.) From and after the passing of this Act, no elector shall at any general election of Members of the House of Representatives, vote in respect of more than one electorate. Electors not to vote in several districts.

(2.) At any other than a general election, no elector shall vote in respect of any electorate, unless he shall have voted in such electorate at the last election held therein, or unless he be a resident elector of such electoral district.
