A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest the Management of the Port of Whangarei in the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Whangarei, and to endow the said Port. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 **1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Whangarei Port Act, 1877.” Short Title.
- 2.** The Port of Whangarei shall comprise from high watermark on the south-eastern bank of the Otika River as far as the tide flows up the Whangarei River, including both banks of the said Whangarei River, to high watermark of ordinary spring tides. Boundaries of port.
- 10 **3.** The entire management and control of the Port of Whangarei, in the Provincial District of Auckland, is hereby vested in the Chairman and Council of the County of Whangarei. Management of port vested in County Council.
- 4.** All the land mentioned or described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby vested in the Chairman, Councillors, and inhabitants of the County of Whangarei as an endowment for the said port. Endowment of port with land.
- 15 **5.** It shall be lawful for the Waste Lands Board of the Provincial District of Auckland to sell, lease, and dispose of the said land described in the Schedule to this Act in manner provided by the law for the time being in force for the sale, letting, and disposal of waste lands of the Crown in the said provincial district. Land to be sold, &c., by Waste Lands Board.
- 20 **6.** All moneys to arise from the sale, letting, and disposal of the said land shall be paid over to the Chairman and Councillors of the said County of Whangarei, to be expended in the improvement of the said harbour and works connected therewith. How money to be spent.
