PRIMARY PRODUCTS MARKETING (REGULATIONS CONFIRMATION) BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill relates to regulations made under section 3 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953. Such regulations are required by that Act to be laid before Parliament within 16 sitting days of their being made, and expire at the end of the session during which they are laid before Parliament unless confirmed by Parliament during that session.

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title.

Clause 2 validates and confirms the Berryfruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1, the Game Industry Board Regulations 1985, and the Game Industry Board Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1.

Clause 3 repeals the Primary Products Marketing Regulations Confirmation Act 1983, which is now spent.
