

PRIMARY PRODUCTS MARKETING (REGULATIONS CONFIRMATION) BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill confirms 2 sets of regulations made under the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953. That Act provides that regulations made under it lapse after a time unless validated or confirmed by Act of Parliament.

Both sets of regulations relate to the kiwifruit industry.

Clause 1 relates to the Bill's Short Title.

Clause 2 provides that the Bill binds the Crown.

Clause 3 validates and confirms the regulations.

Clause 4 repeals an earlier, spent, confirmation.
