

PRIMARY PRODUCTS MARKETING REGULATIONS CONFIRMATION BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill validates and confirms regulations made under section 3 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953 and laid before Parliament during the present session. Unless so confirmed, the regulations will, by virtue of section 4 (1) of that Act, expire with the close of the last day of this session.

The regulations validated and confirmed are the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1 which provide—

- (a) For the name of the Kiwifruit Marketing Licensing Authority to be changed to the New Zealand Kiwifruit Authority;
- (b) For increases in the amounts of the kiwifruit levy and exporter's licence fee;
- (c) For numerous miscellaneous amendments relating to procedure.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to validate and confirm regulations made under section 3 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Primary Products Marketing Regulations Confirmation Act 1981.

2. Regulations confirmed—The Kiwifruit Marketing
10 Licensing Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1 are hereby
declared to be valid and are hereby confirmed as required by
section 4 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953.

3. Repeal—The Primary Products Marketing Regulations Confirmation Act 1980 is hereby repealed.
