PRIMARY PRODUCTS MARKETING REGULATIONS CONFIRMATION BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill validates and confirms regulations made under section 3 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953 and laid before Parliament during the present session. Unless so confirmed, the regulations will, by virtue of section 4 (1) of that Act, expire with the close of the last day of this session.

The regulations validated and confirmed are-

1. The Citrus Marketing Authority (Dissolution) Regulations 1981, which provide for the dissolution of the Authority after the payment of its debts, and for the transfer of the balance of its property to various grower co-operatives set up to take over the functions of the Authority:

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to validate and confirm regulations made under section 3 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Primary Products Marketing Regulations Confirmation Act 1982.
- 2. Regulations confirmed—The regulations specified in 10 the Schedule to this Act are hereby declared to be valid and are hereby confirmed as required by section 4 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953.
 - 3. Repeal—The Primary Products Marketing Regulations Confirmation Act 1981 is hereby repealed.
