A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower certain Public Departments to Title. pay otherwise than to Executors or Administrators small sums due on account of Pay or Allowances to Persons deceased.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Public Payments Short Title. without Probate Act 1869."

2. On the death of any person to whom any sum of money not Power to Colonial exceeding fifty pounds may be payable by a Public Department Treasurer to pay sums under #50 in respect of civil or military pay or allowances or annuities granted due to a person under authority of the General Assembly it shall be lawful for the deceased without requiring probate. Colonial Treasurer on being satisfied of the expediency of dispensing with probate or letters of administration to authorize the payment of such sum or any part or parts thereof to any person or persons whom the Colonial Treasurer may consider entitled thereto without requiring the production of probate or of letters of administration under such regulations as shall be made by the Governor in Council under this Act and shall from time to time be in force hercunder.

3. On the death of any person to whom any sum of money similar power to not exceeding fifty pounds may be payable by the Government Provincial and County Governments. granted under authority of the General Assembly or of the Provincial Council or County Council of such Province or County the Provincial Treasurer or County Treasurer shall have all the same powers as to dispensing with probate and letters of administration as are hereby given to the Colonial Treasurer in similar cases subject to such regulations as aforesaid.

4. It shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time to make Governor empowered alter and revoke such regulations as to him shall seem fit providing to make regulations. for the terms and conditions under which such payments as aforesaid may be made.

5. Any payment made in pursuance of this Act shall be valid Payment under this against all persons whatever and all persons acting under its provision Act a good discharge. shall be absolutely discharged from all liability in respect of any money duly paid or applied by them under this Act.
