A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Plumbers Registration Act, 1912.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Plumbers Registration Act 1912 Amendment Act, 1917.

Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section seven of the Plumbers Registration Act, 1912 (hereinafter called the said Act), every person shall be entitled to registration as a plumber under the said Act who satisfies the Board established under the said Act—

Qualifications of persons entitled to registration as plumbers under this Act.

(a.) That he was at the time of the commencement of the said Act the holder of a certificate or license as a master plumber or journeyman plumber issued by the Drainage Boards of Christchurch or Dunedin or issued under any municipal by-laws applicable to the licensing of plumbers; or

(b.) That, not being the holder of a certificate or license as defined in paragraph (a), he was at the time of the commencement of the said Act fully competent to perform the duties of a sanitary plumber:

Provided that application for registration under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) of this section shall be made within six months from the coming into operation of this Act.

3. The following words shall be added at the end of subsection two of section seven of the said Act: "and of section two of the Plumbers Registration Act 1912 Amendment Act, 1917."
