A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Public Revenues Act, 1910.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:--

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Revenues Amendment Short Title. Act, 1913, and shall form part of and be read together with the Public Revenues Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section fifteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 15 of omitting from subsection one the words "who shall take all such principal Act amended. steps as he thinks fit," and substituting the words "and shall take all such steps as it thinks fit."

If any person having possession or control of any public Prosecution of moneys fraudulently applies, or causes or permits the same or any part thereof to be so applied, to other than public services, or is a defaulter in respect of any such moneys, the Audit Office shall forthwith take all such steps as it thinks fit to prosecute the offender 25 according to law, but nothing herein shall prevent the prosecution of such person by any person other than the Audit Office.
