Title	2. Salary of Controller and Auditor- General
1. Short Title and commencement	

A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to amend the Public Revenues Act 1953**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be  
cited as the Public Revenues Amendment Act 1960, and shall  
be read together with and deemed part of the Public Revenues  
Act 1953\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on  
the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty.

**2. Salary of Controller and Auditor-General**—(1) The  
principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 15,  
and substituting the following section:

15 “15. There shall be paid to the Controller and Auditor-  
General out of the Consolidated Fund, without further appro-  
priation than this section, a salary at the following rates:

“(a) For the period commencing with the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty, and ending with the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, at the rate of three thousand one hundred and fifty pounds a year:

“(b) After the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, at the rate of three thousand five hundred pounds a year.”

(2) Section 3 of the Finance Act 1959 is hereby repealed.
