A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Revenues Act, 1887."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Revenues Act, 1887 (No. 2)." Short Title.

10 2. The words "seven hundred and ninety," in the fourth line of the fifth section of "The Public Revenues Act, 1887," are hereby repealed, and the words "eight hundred and forty" shall be read in lieu thereof. Extension of power to issue deficiency bills.
