2. Power to exclude undesirable persons from public reserve. 3. Police to assist if called upon.

## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to grant Further Facilities for the Proper Control of Title. Public Reserves.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Reserves Control Short Title. Act, 1902."

2. It shall be lawful for the committee of any racing club Power to exclude 10 having control of any public reserve for the purpose of any race indesirable persons from public reserve. meeting to prohibit during the course of any race meeting the use of such reserve by any person whom it is, in the opinion of the committee, desirable to exclude, and to remove any such person from the reserve.

3. It shall be the duty of every constable present, if called upon Police to assist if 15to do so, to assist the committee in carrying out the provisions of called upon. this section.
