A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Sale of Public Reserves.

Title.

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedules hereto have been duly reserved for purposes of public utility, and the said reserves are no longer required for such purposes: And whereas all the aforesaid lands are now vested in Her Majesty, and it is expedient that the same should be sold or otherwise dealt with:

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Reserves Sale Act, 1882."

Short Title.

2. The Governor, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, may declare the lands described in the First Schedule hereto open for sale under "The Land Act, 1877," and he may from time to time alter, amend, or revoke any such Proclamation.

Governor may declare lands described in First Schedule open for sale.

3. The Governor, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, may direct the lands described in the Second Schedule hereto to be sold by the Land Board of the Land District of Auckland under "The Land Act, 1877," as if the same were Crown lands.

Governor may direct lands described in Second Schedule to be sold.

All revenues derived from time to time by the Land Board from the lands last aforesaid shall, after the deduction therefrom of the expenses of their survey and administration, be by the Receiver of Land Revenue paid over to the School Commissioners for the Provincial District of Auckland.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement three acres two roods eleven perches, more or less, being a portion of Suburban Section ten of Block nine, Opunake Survey District: commencing at the south-eastern corner of the said section; and bounded generally Southerly and Westerly by the South Road, nine hundred and thirty-seven links; thence generally Northerly by other portion of said section, by lines three hundred, one hundred and seven, and three hundred and seventy-eight links; and thence South-easterly by Suburban Section eleven to the commencing point, six hundred and seventy-eight links.

Also all that piece or parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement thirty perches, more or less, being a portion of Suburban Section nine, Block nineteen, Opunake Survey District: commencing at the south-eastern corner of said section; and bounded generally Southerly by Suburban Section eight, one hundred and ninety-nine links; thence generally Northerly and Westerly by other portion of said Section nine, by lines two hundred and six and thirty-links; and thence generally North-easterly by the South Road to commencing point, one hundred and ninety links.
