A BILL INTITULED

An Act to authorise the Sale or other Disposition of certain Title. Public Reserves.

WHEREAS the lands in the Schedule hereto have been duly Preamble. 5 reserved for certain purposes of public utility, and are no longer required for such purposes: And whereas all the said lands are now vested in Her Majesty, and it is expedient that the same should be sold or appropriated for other purposes respectively:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

as follows:--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Reserves Sale Short Title. Act, 1887."

2. The lands described in the Schedule hereto are hereby dis-Reserves in 15 charged from reservation, and may be sold or otherwise disposed of sold or otherwise under "The Land Act, 1885," or any Act amending the same, in disposed of. such manner as the Governor may direct, and at such prices as he may notify in the Gazette. Nothing herein contained shall preclude the Governor from reserving any of such lands for purposes of public utility as he shall think fit.
