A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Petty Sessions Act, 1865."

WHEREAS by the twelfth section of "The Petty Sessions Act, Preamble. 1865," it is enacted that any Justice of the Peace who shall, except from some unavoidable cause or accident, fail twice in any current year in attending such Court as in the said Act mentioned, on the days appointed for his attendance according to such rota or list to be settled as the said Act provided, shall be removed from the Commission of the Peace by the Governor, and shall be disqualified from being replaced in such Commission for the space of one year from the date of such removal: Provided such Justice of the Peace does not 10 reside further than twenty-five miles from the place of meeting of the Petty Sessions: And whereas it is expedient that the said twelfth section of "The Petty Sessions Act, 1865," should be repealed:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Petty Sessions Act Short Title. Amendment Act, 1874."

2. The said twelfth section of "The Petty Sessions Act, 1865," Section 12 of "Petty shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
