A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to repeal the Public Safety Conservation Act  
1932**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Safety Conservation Act Repeal Act 1987.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1987.

**23. Repeal of Public Safety Conservation Act 1932**—  
The following enactments are hereby repealed:

- (a) The Public Safety Conservation Act 1932;
- (b) The Public Safety Conservation Amendment Act 1960;
- (c) Section 26 (a) of the Petroleum Demand Restraint Act 1981;
- (d) Section 84 (2) of the Civil Defence Act 1983;
- (e) So much of the First Schedule to the Constitution Act 1986 as relates to the Public Safety Conservation Act 1932.
