## A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend the Public Service Classification and Superan- Title. nuation Act. 1908.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service Classification Short Title. and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1912, and shall form part of and be read together with the Public Service Classification and 10 Superannuation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section forty-nine of the principal Act, as amended by sec-Government tion thirty of the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Contribution to Public Service Fund Amendment Act, 1909, is hereby amended by omitting the words increased.
