A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Act, 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1912, and shall form part of and be read together with the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. Section forty-nine of the principal Act, as amended by section thirty of the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1909, is hereby amended by omitting the words "twenty-three thousand pounds," and substituting the words "forty-eight thousand pounds." Government contribution to Public Service Fund increased.

3. Section thirty-nine of the Public Service Classification and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1908, is hereby amended by omitting the words "seven thousand pounds," and substituting the words "seventeen thousand pounds." Government contribution to Teachers' Fund increased.
