**A BILL INTITULED**

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Public Services of New Zealand.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Services Reform Act, 1907.

2. From and after the date of the passing of this Act no person in the employ of the Dominion of New Zealand in any of the public services shall be dismissed or discharged only for the expression of his or her views or opinions on political affairs.
