A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Private Tramways Act, 1882." Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Private Tramways Short Title. Amendment Act, 1891."

2. Subject to the provisions of "The Private Tramways Act, Private tramways 1882" (herein referred to as "the said Act"), any private transvay may be constructed upon parts of 10 may be authorised to be constructed upon or along any part of any streets street or road.

3. For the purpose of connecting any colliery with any shipping For connecting place or railway-station, and subject as aforesaid, any private tramway colliery with shipping or railway, may be authorised to be constructed upon or along any street or be constructed along 15 road; and the local authority may from time to time grant a license streets. for any such tramway for any term not exceeding ten years, upon such special or particular conditions as the said local authority shall think fit, anything contained in sections seven and ten of the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

4. Section twenty-one of "The Public Works Act 1882 Amend-Repeal. 20 ment Act, 1884," is hereby repealed.
