A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Public Trust Office Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Trust Office Amendment
Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the
Public Trust Office Act, 1908. Short Title.

10 2. Section two of the Public Trust Office Amendment Act, 1912,
is hereby amended as follows:— Further provision
for appointment of
Local Deputies of
Public Trustee.

(a.) By omitting from subsection one the words “(not exceeding
four in all)”; and

(b.) By repealing paragraph (c) of the said subsection one.
