ANALYSIS.

Title. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Public Trust Office Consolidation Title. Act, 1894."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Trust Office short Title. Act, 1901," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Public Trust Office Consolidation Act, 1894" (hereinafter referred

10 to as "the principal Act").

2. The principal Act is hereby amended as follows : As to Principal Act section twenty-seven thereof, by adding at the end of the proviso the amended. following words: namely, "Provided, further, that an order of a Judge of the Supreme Court shall not be required when the property

15 to be dealt with under subsections one, two, three, four, and seven does not exceed the value of two thousand pounds."

3. Section eighteen of "The Public Trust Office Act Amend- "The Public Trust ment Act, 1893" (which section was excepted from repeal and Office Act Amend-ment Act, 1893," (ontinued in operation by the principal Act), is hereby amended by amended. 20 repealing the word "seven" in subsection (a) thereof, and substi-

tuting in lieu thereof the word "five."
