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A BILL INTITULED

An Act to repeal "The Payments to Provinces Act Title. 1870" and to make other provision in thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the second second in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Payments to Short Title.
5 Provinces Act 1871." This Act shall subject to the provisions contained in "The Public Revenues Act Amendment Act 1871" deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July last.

2. "The Payments to Provinces Act 1870" is hereby repealed.

3. For the purposes of this Act and "The Public Revenues Act Term "Capitation 10 Amendment Act 1871" the term "Capitation Money" shall mean Money" interpreted. the amounts to be credited each year under this Act to each Province and the County of Westland.

The yearly sums of which an equal twelfth part is to be credited monthly to each Province and the County of Westland shall be ascer-

15 tained as hereinafter provided.

4. The said amounts shall be ascertained in each year by Amounts to be multiplying the sum of fifteen shillings by the number of the population for such year of the Province or County with which the monthly account to be prepared in accordance with the provisions of "The Public Revenues Act Amendment Act 1871" is being prepared and

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adding to the sum so ascertained the amount (if any) for the time being to be credited to such Province or County as a special allowance as hereinafter provided.

5. The following amounts shall be credited to the several Pro-

To the Province of Hawke's Bay for each and every year the sum of one thousand five hundred pounds.

To the Province of Wellington for each and every year the 15 sum of seven hundred and fifty pounds..

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To the Province of Taranaki for each and every year the sum of two hundred and fifty pounds.

6. The number of the population of each Province and of the

County of Westland in each year shall for each year be determined for 20 the purposes of this Act by Resolution of both Houses of the General Assembly.

7. If on the first day of July in any year the number of the population of any Province or County shall not have been determined for the year commencing on that day by Resolution as hereinbefore 25 provided the Registrar-General appointed under "The Registration Act 1858" shall furnish to the Colonial Treasurer an estimate of the number of the population of such Province or County for the year commencing on such first day of July and the number stated in such estimate shall until the passing of a Resolution determining the num- 30 ber be deemed to be the number of the population of such Province or County for such year for the purposes of this Act.

8. In determining under the preceding sections of this Act the numbers of the population of the several Provinces in the North Island the Maori inhabitants thereof shall not be counted and for the 35 purposes of this Act the word "Maori" shall include half-castes living as members of or with Maori Tribes.

9. All the provisions of "The Public Revenues Act 1867" as altered by other Acts heretofore or in this Session or hereafter passed altering or amending the same and all the provisions of "The County 40 of Westland Act 1868" as altered by other Acts heretofore or in this Session or hereafter passed altering or amending the same relating to the sums with which the several Provinces and the County of Westland shall be debited to the payments to be made to the several Provincial Accounts and to the County of Westland Account to the withholding 45 of payments to the several Provincial Accounts and to the County of Westland Account and to payments to be made in certain cases to the Consolidated Fund shall continue in force and have the same application as if the Capitation Moneys by this Act directed to be placed to the credit of the several Provinces and of the County of 50 Westland were so placed under the provisions of the forty-fourth section of "The Public Revenues Act 1867."

ROAD BOARD ALLOWANCES.

Interpretation. " Auditor."

10. In the construction of the sections of this Act herein- 55 after contained the term "Auditor" shall mean the Provincial Auditor of a Province and the Deputy Provincial Auditor when he is acting in the stead of the Provincial Auditor and with reference to the County of Westland it shall mean the Auditor of the County of Westland The term "Road Board" shall mean any Road 60 Board Board of Wardens or other Board Trustees or other person or "Road Board." body having the control of the roads and public highways within any district or town.

11. In each and every year till otherwise enacted there shall be £100,000 to be 5 paid out of the moneys for the time being standing to the credit of the Public Works Fund the sum of one hundred thousand pounds which shall be divided among and paid to the several Provinces and the County of Westland in proportion to their respective populations as

fixed for the time being for the purposes of this Act.

12. All sums paid under the last preceeding section to any Province or the County of Westland as the case may be shall be paid into
to special account. the Bank at which the Provincial Account or the County of Westland Account as the case may be is for the time being kept and shall there be placed to the credit of a special account to be called the Road Dis-15 trict Funds Account of the Province or County and all moneys for the time being standing to the credit of the said account shall be disposed of and accounted for in manner hereinafter provided.

13. The said moneys shall be available only for division among Scheme of disposal the Road Boards of the Province or County in accordance with a of money to be prepared by Scheme to be proposed for each year by the Superintendent or Deputy Superintendent and Superintendent of the Province or the Chairman of the County Council approved. of the County for his Province or County as the case may be and approved by Resolutions of both Houses of the General Assembly.

For the first year the schemes shall be such schemes as shall have 25 been proposed under the fourteenth section of the Act hereby repealed and shall have been approved of by Resolutions passed by both Houses of the General Assembly in this Session of Parliament.

14. The Houses of the General Assembly may amend any proposed Assembly may scheme before approving it but such amendments shall not have amend scheme. 30 effect until both Houses concur therein.

15. In the case of Provinces no money shall be drawn out of any In Provinces money such account or be issued or paid by any person having the custody or warrant. control thereof except by the person for the time being authorized to draw money out of the Provincial Account in pursuance of warrant 35 under the hand of the Superintendent of the Province directed to such

person and certified by the Auditor.

16. Every such warrant as aforesaid shall before the same is Auditor to certify signed by the Superintendent be laid before the Auditor who shall not certify the same unless the sums therein specified are then legally 40 available for the services therein specified by virtue of a scheme approved as herein provided.

17. If any Anditor in the case of a Province shall certify any Penalty on Auditor warrant for payment of money out of the said account except in illegally certifying. accordance with the provisions of this Act he shall be liable to forfeit 45 and pay to Her Majesty the sum of five hundred pounds and an additional sum equal to the amount of the sum for which such warrant shall have been made and all such sums together with full costs of suit shall be recoverable by action suit or information in the Supreme Court in like manner as money due to Her Majesty within 50 the Colony.

18. Every Auditor shall at such times as the Governor shall Auditor to furnish from time to time direct prepare and furnish to the Governor an accounts. account showing in what manner and for what purposes any moneys have been drawn out of the said account and for that purpose shall 55 have all the powers which by the seventeenth eighteenth and nineteenth sections of "The Provincial Audit Act 1866" are conferred upon Provincial Auditors.

19. In the case of the County of Westland no money shall be In Westland money drawn from the said account except by cheque signed by the County to be drawn out by 60 Treasurer and countersigned by the Chairman of the County Council and the Auditor for the County of Westland or by the said Auditor

Penalties.

furnish satisfactory accounts before receiving payments. and one Member of the said Council appointed by the Council for the purpose and such Treasurer shall not sign nor shall such Chairman or any Member of the said Council countersign any such cheque unless the same shall be for a purpose authorized by a scheme approved as aforesaid and if such Treasurer or Chairman or any 5 such Member shall sign or countersign any such cheque except in accordance with the provisions of this Act he shall over and beyond any other penalty or punishment he may thereby have rendered himself liable to forfeit and pay a penalty of five hundred pounds to be recovered in the Supreme Court at the suit of the Auditor for the 10 County for the benefit of the Consolidated Fund and if any such Auditor shall countersign any such cheque except in accordance with the provisions of this Act he shall over and beyond any other penalty or punishment he may have rendered himself liable to forfeit and pay a penalty of five hundred pounds to be recovered in the Supreme 15 Court at the suit of the Attorney-General for the benefit of the Consolidated Fund: Provided however that the recovery of any such penalty shall not discharge any such Chairman Treasurer Member or Auditor from any suit for the recovery of any money which he shall have illegally drawn from such account.

20. No payment shall after the first year be made under this Act to any Road Board in any year until such Board shall have furnished to the Superintendent of the Province an account in such form as may be prescribed by the Colonial Secretary showing its receipts and disbursements during the past year and such other 25 information as may be required by the Colonial Secretary.

Such accounts shall be transmitted by the Superintendent to the Colonial Secretary and a return compiled therefrom shall be laid before both Houses of the General Assembly within thirty days after the commencement of the next ensuing Session.

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
