PUBLIC WORKS ACTS AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to further amend "The Public Works Act, 1882," and the Title.
Acts amending the same.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Works Acts Short Title.
Amendment Act, 1892." It shall be read together with "The Public
Works Act, 1882," and the several Acts amending the same.

10 2. The following proviso shall be added to section four of "The Proviso.
Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1887:—

Provided that in the case of those counties in which the opera-
tion of "The Counties Act, 1876," or of any Act repealing or amend-
ing the same, is suspended, or partially suspended, the local authority
15 in whom the exclusive care, control, or managment of any such
bridge, ferry, or ford may by any such Proclamation be vested shall
be deemed to have, and may exercise for the time being by virtue of
such Proclamation, in addition to the powers that they may already
20 have in that behalf, the power of making, altering, or revoking by-
laws on all or any of the subjects as set forth in section seventeen of
"The Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1887," any Act or thing to
the contrary notwithstanding.
