**A BILL INTITULED**

**AN ACT** to amend "The Public Works Acts Amendment Act, 1900." Title.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Works Amendment Act, 1901." Short Title.

2. In any case where under section twenty-one of "The Public Works Acts Amendment Act, 1900," the owner of land is required to dedicate land for the purpose of widening a street, he shall be entitled to compensation from the local authority, to be assessed under the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1894": Compensation on widening of street.

Provided that section twenty-one of the said Act shall not apply to subdivisions fronting on existing streets.
