## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Public Works Acts Amendment Act, Title. 1900."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Works Amend- Short Title. ment Act, 1901."

2. In any case where under section twenty-one of "The Public Compensation on 10 Works Acts Amendment Act, 1900," the owner of land is required to dedicate land for the purpose of widening a street, he shall be entitled to compensation from the local authority, to be assessed under the provisions of "The Public Works Act, 1894":

Provided that section twenty-one of the said Act shall not apply 20 to subdivisions fronting on existing streets.
