A BILL INTITLED

An Act to amend "The Public Works Act, 1903."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Works Amend-
ment Act, 1904," and it shall form part of and be read together with
"The Public Works Act, 1894," and the several amendments
thereof.

Short Title.

10 2. Lands shown as a road or street in or by any plan of sub-
division at any time heretofore deposited in any Deeds Register
Office or Lands Registry Office shall be deemed to be existing roads
or streets within the meaning of subsection one of section two of
"The Public Works Act, 1903."
